

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs): International Calling

1. What is International Calling?

International Calling is a service that allows you as a Telkom Mobile subscriber to make calls from South Africa to other countries where Telkom Mobile has dialling agreements

2. How to activate International Calling?

- For Prepaid customers, International calling is available by default.
- All contract and Top Up customers must activate the service by:
 - Visiting the nearest Telkom Mobile store
 - Calling 081180 free from your Telkom Mobile phone
 - E-mail us on enterPEM@Telkom.co.za

3. How much does International cost?

- International SMS costs R1.50
- International MMS costs R4.50

4. How are International Calls billed?

- International Calls are billed on a per minute billing method except for Smart One-Rate plan.
- Smart One rate applies to the following countries only:

5. Can I use my FreeMe freebies whilst roaming?

International calling is excluded from the FreeMe Promo All-networks Voice Bundles and will be charged at applicable international call rates

6. Can I use my inclusive minutes and SMS for International services?

No. International calling and SMS are excluded from the inclusive values and will be charged at applicable international call rates

7. How do I make an international call?

- To call internationally from most mobile or smart phones simply dial the "+" sign, followed by the country code, city code and local phone
- To call a South African subscriber roaming abroad, just dial their cell phone number (e.g., 067 123 1234)

8. How do I send International SMS & MMS?

The dialling prefix is + when sending outside South Africa, followed by the country code and the receipt number. E.g. +33 67 789 9871
